## About E-Filing:

In Church Windows Payroll 2019 we have an e-filing file available for SSA. Many states will also accept this file and we have tried to accommodate as many states as possible. There is also e-filing available through a new partner, TaxBandits, for an economical no hassle alternative. The same file you create for SSA can be sent to TaxBandits. They can validate that the file is acceptable to the SSA and State (if applicable), **AND** print and mail your W-2s. This is truly a time saving option. There is a link to the TaxBandits web site at the end of the file creation screen in Church Windows Payroll so you can set up your account.

To use the no-cost filing option directly through the SSA, you will need to register with the SSA Business Services Online. This can also be done by phone. [Here's a link to the more info from Social Security Business Services Online.](#)

At the Business Services Online (BSO) page, in the right-column, you can click on the "+" sign in front of *For Employers* and access the *BSO Registration and BSO Services Handbook*, a *Registration Video*, and other useful information.

Many states have lower threshold requirements for electronic filing of W-2s than what the Federal Government requires. States may require separate registration for electronic filing. Contact your State Tax Department for details. You may file electronically with the state and submit paper copies to the federal government if you submitted 250 or fewer W-2s for 2017.
